



**Remarks from the Director of Christian Science Nursing
Clearview Home Grand Opening and Annual Gathering
June 29, 2019**

Hello. I am Brian Harned, Director of Operations here at Clearview Home, and I am happy you came to share this day with us.

Jeffrey Deemer-White, our Director of Christian Science nursing, is unable to join us today, but sends his love and hopes everybody will love this new building as much as he does.

I was Co-Director of Christian Science Nursing with Jeffrey for most of last year. I will give this report in Jeffrey's absence.

Clearview Home continues to have an active Christian Science Nursing Department. Christian Science nurses have ministered and cared for more than 20 patients here last year, and this year will be just as active.

That's because Clearview Home's Christian Science nursing activities are a vital component of Christian Science healing in our 5-state region. In fact, several times last year, our visiting nurses lovingly cared for Christian Scientists traveling to the Milwaukee area! In addition, local church members who needed bandaging were warmly welcomed by our nurses who provided this outpatient care.

Our department continues to see patients coming in and being healed. In fact, some of them improve so much that they can complete their healing at home. All have expressed gratitude for the love and care received from our Christian Science nurses and the healing atmosphere they felt while at Clearview.

The following healing is a perfect example of this:

An individual came to Clearview Home unable to stand, sit, sleep, eat, or breath easily. Our Christian Science nursing staff worked with this person to find comfort and peace in a healing atmosphere, while the patient worked with a Christian Science practitioner the whole time. This spiritual teamwork resulted in healing within a few weeks. As a result, the patient returned home and went back to work completed restored.

During a follow-up call, this person expressed gratitude for the wonderful healing and having a Christian Science Nursing facility so accessible.

This was only one of many healings we have witnessed this past year.

With an increase in patients, we have seen God supplying "willing hearts and hands" to the Christian Science nursing staff. New staff housing arrangements have helped to create a peaceful and safe environment for these Christian Science nurses and their families.

We anticipate continued growth in staffing, meaning that established services can also expand and develop over the next several years. Our main focus will continue to be Christian Science nursing, visiting Christian Science nursing and outpatient services.

For this reason, we cherish training dedicated members of The Mother Church to become Christian Science nurses and are thankful for our ability to meet our expanding needs through local support. So, if you know members of your branch church who shares a love and joy in serving others, please encourage them to think about training to be a Christian Science nurse.
